The Linville Foundation was established almost 60 years ago to assist Linville's summer employees (and children of employees) in realizing their dream of higher education. Since that time, the Foundation has awarded over 2500 scholarships and thousands of dollars in financial aid.


As one in a long line of scholarship recipients, here are a few things you need to know. Please read the following carefully:

- The attached scholarship application is due no later than noon on **Friday, July 26**. You may email it to me at: betsy@linvillegolfclub.com, or drop a copy by my office at 87 Carolina Avenue.
- Each person on the Linville Foundation Board of Directors receives a copy of your application. If you complete the fillable application, **please use Adobe Acrobat, not Google**. If you fill out your application by hand, please write legibly using black ink and check your spelling.
- The week after the Resort closes, you'll receive a letter letting you know the amount of your scholarship. After providing proof of enrollment, you'll receive this amount divided equally into two checks—one check in the fall and the second one after January 1.
- You must be taking at least 12 hours at the school you are attending to be eligible for a scholarship that semester. In some cases, internships can take the place of classes, but you must be considered a full-time student by your school.
- Before you can receive either your fall or spring scholarship check, you must send me an official proof of enrollment from your school. This form may be found online through your student account or sent from the registrar's office. **It must show that you're taking 12 hours or indicate that you are a full-time student. Please do not send proof of enrollment for spring term until after January 1.** You will not receive a reminder for spring term. It is your responsibility to send your proof of enrollment after the first of the year.
- **Your scholarship check will be mailed to the address on your application.** If you move it's your responsibility to contact me with your new address. In the past, we have encountered problems with mail delivered to student apartments, so you may consider having your checks sent to your permanent (or parents') address.

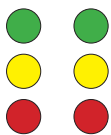
